Trying to find your way around the legal system to get your EVCPs (EV charge points) connected quickly?

Our land rights department are now reducing timelines for connecting your EV charge points.

How are we doing this?

A number of our customers wish to own a Substation for EV charging points. We can offer our customers a Licence as opposed to a conventional Lease which reduces time and enables speedy connection.

Our Licence covers our equipment and access to the Substation, provided you have a Lease with the Landowner – even a short one of 10-20 years.

We don't require a Lease, just a Licence between us for our equipment.


- No more lengthy transactions just a simple wayleave signed by your landlord as landowner in respect of our LV cables.
- > No involvement with external agents.
- > No additional fees we'll handle the land rights free of charge providing there are no LV cables or access required from another third party landowner in these cases we would require an easement from that landowner and any costs made by their Solicitors would be payable by you.

NB: if cables fall outside your Lease then it may be necessary to take a Wayleave with the Landowner for any cables in their land – this is a simple form which needs completing and signing by the Landowner. We can assist you with this.
