What Legals will be required?

The extent of legalities is different for each project.

Easements are usually needed for gas pipes, electricity cables and equipment.


Transfers and/or leases are necessary if a substation/ gas governor/apparatus/fibre installation is going to be installed. Easements will be necessary if a third-party landowner is involved.


Our in-house legal team will liaise with you, your solicitors and – if needed – the landowner's solicitors with the necessary documentation to deliver you a quick and efficient service.
